

# PAUL DIVIDES MEN INTO 3 CLASSES:

## **1. THE NATURAL MAN – 1 Corinthians 2:14**

Psuchikos – Meaning: of the senses, sensual, earthly; this is the Adamic Man, unregenerated though the new birth (John 3:35), the natural man may be educated, eloquent and intelligent but the spiritual content of Scripture is absolutely hidden from him.

*Not born of the spirit. Jude 19*

## **2. THE SPIRITUAL CHRISTIAN – 1 Corinthians 2:15**

Pneumatikos – This is the renewed man, Spirit filled and walking in the Spirit in full communion with God (Ephesians 5:18-20).

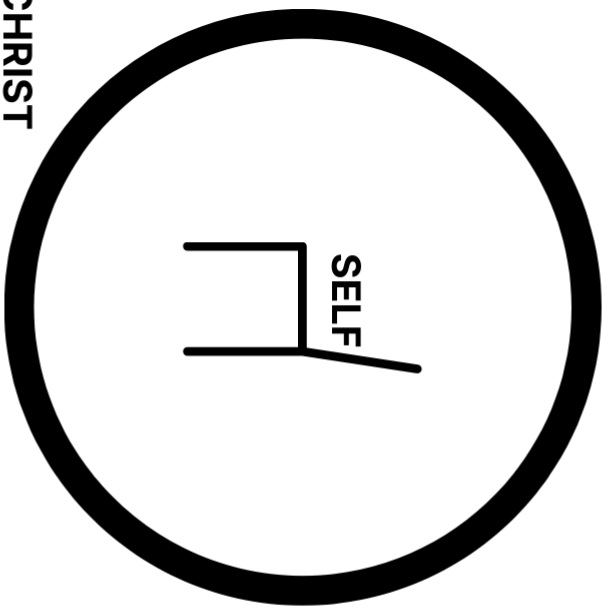
*Spirit Controlled. A Christian who walks in the Spirit.*

## **3. THE CARNAL MAN – 1 Corinthians 3:1**

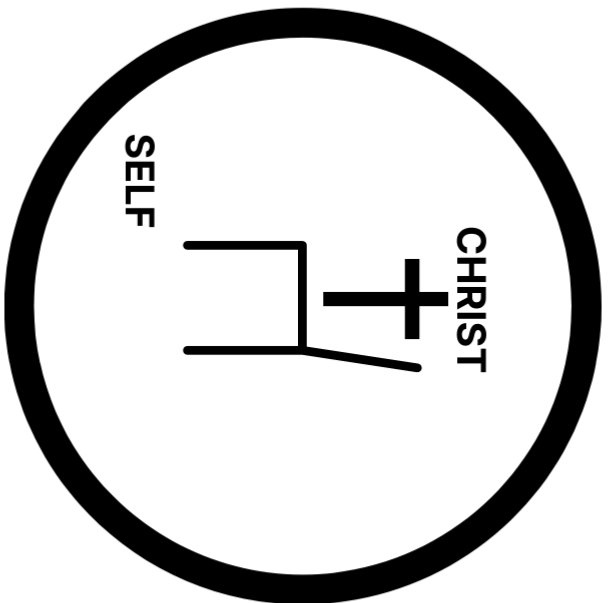
Sarkikos – This is the renewed man who, walking “according to the flesh”, remains a baby in Christ. The worldly Christian can only understand the simplest truths of the Bible; only the milk of the Word, and not solid food (1 Corinthians 3:2).

*A Christian who walks according to the flesh. One who remains immature in his Christian conduct.*
